OFF-LICENCE RENEWAL

Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 - Section 135

To SRS GHUMAN & SONS LIMITED

The off-licence in respect of the premises situated at 76 Gladstone Road, Richmond and known as "Big Barrel Richmond" is renewed. Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, <u>SRS GHUMAN & SONS LIMITED</u> is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act. The present conditions of the licence continue to apply. These are as follows:

CONDITIONS

- 1. HOURS: Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - (a) Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 10.00 pm
 - (b) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.

2. RESTRICTIONS:

- (a) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
- (b) There are to be no single sales of RTDs.
- (c) There are to be no sales of "shots", "bombs" or other single serve packages of spirits or liqueurs equivalent in strength to one or more standard drinks per package.
- (d) With the exception of craft beers, there are to be no single sales of any beer in containers under 500ml.
- WATER: While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, free drinking water must be provided for customers at the tasting location.
- 4. DESIGNATED AREAS: The whole of the premises is designated as a Supervised area. The defined area is the area outlined on the plan received 18 February 2016.
- 5. SIGNAGE: Signage must be displayed at each point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on
